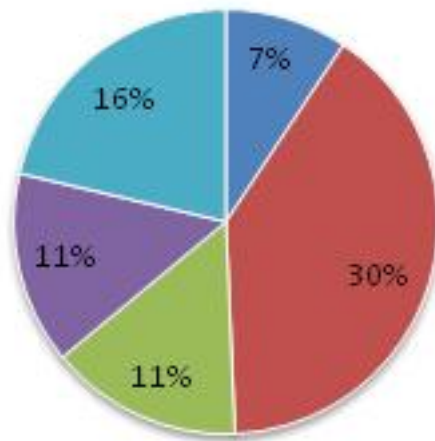


Energy Improvement Example

The example uses a 1500sqft, 3-bedroom typical older Florida home. The single largest energy end-use in Florida homes is for cooling. Of cooling the biggest energy waster is typically windows. We can help reduce the energy load for each of the categories listed above.

■ Heating ■ Cooling ■ Lighting ■ Refrigeration ■ Hot Water



Reducing electricity demand in Florida by 29 percent below what is projected for 2023 could result in 14,264 jobs and a cumulative net savings of \$5.1 billion.

How does Florida use electricity?

Florida's energy is used to power:

- homes (51 percent),
- businesses (40 percent), and
- industry (9 percent).

Per capita residential electricity use is 6,482 kilowatt hours per year, 43 percent greater than the national average.
